

# School in South Korea



In Korea, there are six years of primary school, three years of lower secondary school and three years of upper secondary school, which is either academic or vocational. South Korea offers free half-day public preschools (called kindergartens) for three- to five-year olds.

**In this period, children learn Moral Education, Korean Language, Social Studies, Mathematics, Science, P.E, Music and Art.**

**They go to school from 8.00 a.m to 4.00 p.m**

Formerly in Korea, students, went to class from Monday to Saturday and their holidays were longer. However, today they attend school from Monday to Friday, which reduces the holiday period.

**They are not homeschooled.**

They have the possibility to be part of a K-pop group, so some students, from the age of 11, leave school and go to train at a label to be singers in a k-pop group

**They wear a uniform to go to school.**
